

## Emery County School District | Board of Education

The February 13, 2020 meeting of the Board of Education, held at the Emery County School District office, was called to order at 6:30 pm by Board President Tracey Johnson. Vice-President Marie Johnson and members Kenzi Guymon, Royd Hatt, and Jessy Johansen were also present. Business Administrator Jared Black was in attendance.

President Johnson led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

President Johnson thanked audience members for attending the meeting and welcomed them. She opened the meeting by giving the following statement on behalf of the Board of Education:

Board Member Jessy Johansen made a motion to appoint Jared Black as District Superintendent, effective July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Member Marie Johnson seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
